14 Day Schedule for Prayer

We start on Wednesday, November 8, 2006, at 6:45 PM. No Wednesday night dinners during this two week period, so please eat (or fast!) before you come, so we can start promptly at 6:45 and finish at 8:45. (We are being asked to fast from one thing a day, so for many of us fasting through the meal closest to our prayer time might be one consideration—simply fast until the next regular mealtime. Of course, fasting from food is only one way to fast, and it might not work for medical reasons for some of us.)

On Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, we will meet at the church from 8 AM to 10 AM.

On Saturdays, we will meet from 10 AM until noon.

On Sundays, we will meet at 8:30 AM until worship at 10:30 AM.

We start on Wednesday, November 8th and end on Tuesday, November 21st.

We will start each session with silent meditation while some meditative Christian music plays in the background. During that time our goal is to settle down, collect ourselves, and open up our hearts and minds to what God has to say to us. We'll take the first 15-20 minutes or so to do this each time.

Then we will share our prayer thoughts and anything we might have received from the Lord. We will read whatever Scriptures if any the Lord has highlighted to each of us. Then we will settle back with some more music and meditative prayer time. Of course, through all of this we are to be open to how the Spirit desires to move among us.

Each of us will have a journal to write down what we get from the Lord in the way of revelations, visions, dreams, or insights into Scripture. Everyone participates in this, from the youngest to the oldest. Our children are to play a significant role in this process, and we need to be attentive to them throughout these 14 days of prayer and seeking the Lord.

Remember the promise of Scripture: Those who seek the Lord with all their heart and soul will find Him!

This is an exciting and blessed time in the life of our church. If you are a friend of AllPoints, please remember us each day in prayer as we are meeting each day at the church. We want to be obedient in all we do before the Lord!
